Looking back to the start of the school year it is hard to believe how much we have grown! We added grade 9 with students from Nigeria, Syria, China, Japan, Canada, Senegal. This year we have 17 different nationalities represented in a student population!

We continue to update our facilities, with new snack bar, and many rooms freshly painted: student work area, laundry room, hallways and our large Kilmarnock classroom. Almost 30,000 students wrote the test from around the world. In total, 18,502 students wrote the Senior test and two of our Merrick Prep students received a Certificate of Distinction for being in the top 20%; Stephen Solaja was in the top 15% and Allen Wu reached the top 2%.


